- Coordinate and verify all layouts and installation of slabs, rough ins, finishes, and equipment
- Manage material take-offs, create sketches from blueprints, review specifications, adjust/approve submittals and release material requisitions.
- Inspect work in progress and completed work to insure conformance to specifications
- Advise senior management of any possible work interferences or scheduling challenges and work to resolve them as appropriate
- Serve as the final trade expert on matters elevated from the field
